Experiments based on various scientific topics including relationship between density & mass, Chemistry Demo etc. The programme was viewed by 1405 virtual audiences.

Sci-mails, the quarterly membership newsletter was published, shared and uploaded on Social Media handles of the Centre. The post has been reached to 4315 people.

International Day of Human Space Flight:

International Day of Human Space Flight was celebrated at the Centre on April 12, 2022 in collaboration with Russian Centre for Science and Culture in Mumbai. The programme started with homage to Cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin by the chief guest, His Excellency Mr Aleksei V Surovtsev, the Consul General of Russia in Mumbai and by the guest of honour, Dr Elena Remizova, Vice-Consul & Director of Russian House in Mumbai along with other 69 invitees by offering flowers. To commemorate the event an online quiz and an open house quiz on the topic 'Space Flight' was organized by the Centre. 772 students registered for the online quiz and 89 students submitted the solutions. 162 visitors participated in the Open House Quiz.

World Health Day:

The Centre commemorated World Health Day as a part of AKAM programme by organising online science quiz on theme 'Health' on 5th April 2022. 141 people solved the quiz.

World Heritage Day:

The Centre commemorated World Heritage Day as a part of AKAM program by organising online science quiz on theme 'Indian Heritage' on 18th April 2022. 231 people solved the quiz.

Earth Day:

The Centre commemorated Earth Day as a part of AKAM program by organising online science quiz on theme Earth on 22nd April 2022. 778 people solved the quiz.

Sci-Birthday:

3 Sci-Birthday programmes were organised on 14th and 23rd April 2022 for 100 children. Children were engaged in making hands on science activities, Science on a Sphere show & gallery visit.

Package Tour

During the month, 09 package tours were organized for about 395 students and teachers. They were given the Guided tour to the galleries, Science Odyssey, Science on Sphere show and Science Shows were organized.

NGO VISITS

During April 2022, in all 5 visits of underprivileged children were organised by different NGO's in Mumbai. 236 children visited the Centre during these visits. Innovation Hub Programmes
