Experiments based on various scientific topics like density, pressure, Newton's third laws, refraction, adhesive force etc. The programme was viewed by 5,637 virtual audiences.

03 Sci-Birthday programmes were organized on 8th, 16th and 17th July, 2022 for 110 children. Children were engaged in hands on science activities, Science on a Sphere show & gallery visit.

Sci-Mail

Sci-mail, the quarterly membership newsletter was published, shared and uploaded on Social Media handles of the Centre. The post has been reached to 4,291 people.

75 Chemistry Facts

The Centre prepared in-house series of 2-3 minutes' duration video clips based on the interesting chemistry facts which we come across in our daily life. From June 1, 2022, in addition to previous months 30 videos 28 new videos were uploaded on Centre's all social media handles – Whatsapp groups, Instagram, Facebook page in the month of July. Reach for these video clips were 25,703.

Innovation Hub Sessions

The Centre started with a new batch at the Innovation Hub for July – September 2022 from 9th July 2022. In all 27 students registered for Integrated Science and 20 students registered for Robotics. Various session such as out-of-the-Box Thinking, improving thinking skills, Tod-Fod-Jod, Introduction to common traits of Innovators & 21st Century skills through wordmat and many other hands-on activities were organized for the members.

Package Tour

Throughout the month, 10 package tours were conducted for 1,014 students and teachers. They were given the Guided tour to the galleries, Science Odyssey, Science on Sphere show and Science Shows.

Training Session

A training session was organized in the Innovation Hub of the Centre on 1st June, 2022 for Education Trainees by Mrs. Manjula U. Yadav, Education Officer, Nehru Science Centre Mumbai.

The topic of the training was 'How to connect with people'. Training included various subtopics such as demonstration, body stature, voice modulations, hand gestures and various other skills and traits required for effective presentation.

The training methodology was interactive as the Officer ensured that knowledge was not only disseminated but accurately perceived and understood by the trainees.

Kathak Wokrshop

The Centre, on the occasion of the 83rd Birth Anniversary of Dr Puru Dadheech organized the Ashitih Utsav, a Kathak Workshop, in collaboration with the Sangeet Natak Akademi. The Akademi also exhibited its valuable publications on performing arts, particularly of India on 17 July 2022. Around 400 Kathak performers and aspirants participated in this workshop.

The webinar was for teachers. Facebook Live Science Demonstration

03 online Science Demonstration shows were conducted through Facebook live programme on every Thursday during the month viz: 14, 21, and 28 July 2022. Experiments based on various scientific topics including cloud formation, Electrolysis of NaCl solution, Centrifugal force etc. The programme was viewed by 450+ virtual audiences.

Science Demonstration Lecture and Science Film Festival programme

Special Science Demonstration Lecture and Science Film Festival programme is organised for the school groups visiting science centre from 17th July 2022 onwards. Science Demonstration lectures on topics 'Colourful Chemistry, Fun with Physics and Matter at

Low Temperature'etc were conducted along with screening of syllabus based selected science films. 743 students from various schools participated in the programme.

REGIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE, BHOPAL

KVS Principals' Meet:

The Centre organised a Principals' Meet of the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) schools of Bhopal region on 11th July, 2022 in hybrid mode (both online and offline) with an aim to popularize the activities of the Centre amongst the KV fraternity of Bhopal region. The Meet was chaired by Shri Somit Shrivastava, Dy Commissioner, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, Bhopal Region. At the outset, Shri Saket Singh Kaurav, PC, RSC, Bhopal briefed the participants about various educational activities to be organised by the Centre round the year especially for students. As a part of the programme, an interactive session with Dr Hashima Hasan, Dy Programme Scientist, JWST, NASA HQ, USA was conducted both on online and offline modes wherein Shri Saket Singh Kaurav, PC, RSCB initiated and moderated the discussion, A total of 500 participants participated in the programme. This was followed by a Question & Answer session on JWST wherein Shri Saket Singh Kaurav, PC, RSCB responded to some queries of the participants on JWST. A total of 150 students from different local schools and colleges participated in the programme. An Open House Quiz was also organised among the students present to test their conceptual grasp over JWST and prizes were awarded to the successful participants of the programme. A total of 150 participants participated in the programme. This was followed by the live telecast of the release of the first JWST images from NASA which was watched by 200 viewers present at the Centre.

Online Lecture on the Life & Work of Stephen Hawking

The Centre organized an online Popular Lecture on the topic 'Close Encounters in Space & Time with Prof Stephen Hawking' on July 15, 2022. Mr Peter Guzzardi, Editor of the best-seller book 'A Brief History of Time' authored by Prof Hawking recounted his days and times with the noted astrophysicist. The programme was live-streamed through the official YouTube channel of the Centre. A total of 650 viewers viewed the programme.

Celebration of Moon Landing Day

The Centre celebrated the Moon Landing Day on 20th July, 2022 to commemorate the landmark occasion of moon landing by humanity in 1969 through the historic Apollo-11 mission sent by NASA . An Open House Quiz on the topic 'Moon : Marvels & Mysteries' was conducted amongst the students of local schools to mark the occasion. At the outset, Shri Saket Singh Kaurav, Project Coordinator of the Centre, briefed the audience regarding the importance of the occasion and the role that the cosmos plays in shaping our daily lives on the Earth. He further interacted with the audience and took several questions from them for clarification at the end of the session. He also gave away the prizes to the successful participants of the quiz on the completion of the programme. A total of 50 participants including students, teachers, parents and house-wives participated in the programme.
