Throughout October 2022, four sessions were conducted covering following topics:

• 01.10.2022 - Using Google Tools:

Google Presentation – Making slide presentation using text, pictures & video. Insert Tables, Pictures, Other shapes, Charts & Graphs. Insert video from drive or from YouTube, Add Transition effects & Animation effects to make presentation attractive, Share Presentation & Print slides 246 teachers participated in this programme

• 08.10.2022 - Using Internet Tools:

Types of Browsers to see Internet, what are Domain names, Use of Emails for communication, Attachments in email, Google account & how versatile it is, Online storage, Blog sites, Dictionary & Thesaurus. 253 teachers participated in this programme.

• 15.10.2022 - Using Google Tools:

Google Forms – Creating forms with text, pictures, video, etc. How to insert Header Image, Add Question with short answer, long answer, paragraph, multiple choice, checkboxes, dropdown etc. How to allow user to upload file & check file responses. How to add title, image, video, section etc. How to set form duration, share it with user's email IDs or send link using WhatsApp/Facebook etc. 215 teachers participated in this programme.

• 29.10.2022 - Using Multimedia Tools:

Canva: What is Canva? How to create professional looking designs using Canva? What are advantages & disadvantages of using Canva? How to make Presentations, videos, whiteboards, Posters, Logos etc. How to use templates or add elements like sticky notes, lines & shapes, graphics, videos, charts, tables, frames or other collection etc.

Video Editor: What is Video editor? How to create, edit & transform videos. How to add title card, Trim & split video & Add text, motion, 3D effects, filters to a video, Change speed of a video. How to add Background music, custom audio to your video & export the finished video. 215 teachers participated in this programme.

1. <u>PSL on 'Artemis Mission: Humanity's Return to the Moon'</u>

On 01.10.2022 an online PSL on the topic 'Artemis Mission: Humanity's Return to the Moon' by Jaydeep Mukherjee, Director, NASA Florida Space Grant Consortium, was conducted on Zoom platform and was streamed on Facebook page of the Centre. The response was overwhelming and we received more than 850 registrations. The zoom meeting was full to its capacity throughout the lecture. The Facebook reach for the lecture is 795.

2. PSL on 'Mars calling! Updates from Mars Perseverance Rover'

On 03.10.2022 an online PSL on the topic 'Mars calling! Updates from Mars Perseverance Rover' by Dr Jenifer Blank, Astrobiology Research Scientist, Division of Space Sciences &

Astrobiology, NASA Ames Research Centre was organized. The lecture was conducted on zoom platform and was simultaneously streamed on the Facebook page of the Centre. The Facebook reach of the event was 1079.
